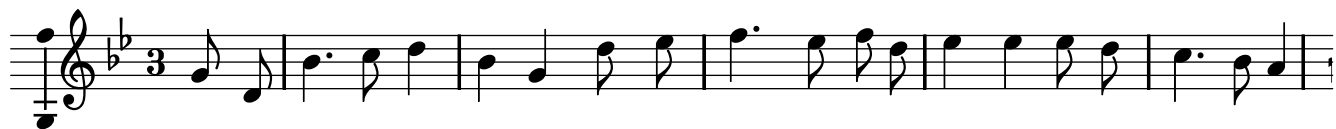


# A Rebus upon Mr. Anthony Hall,
